PROJECT UPDATE

The Ce-VET project is officially into its second year of activities. At the 12-month stage, we're happy to share what lies ahead for the next 18 months! Over the past year, our partners have been busy carrying out key activities designed to strengthen the use of Customised Employment (CE) across Norway, Germany, Italy, Spain, and Ireland.. This has included:

- ◆ **CeVET Mapping:** Project partners analysed the Vocational Education and Training (VET) landscape in each partner country, exploring the opportunities available to individuals with disabilities. The results of this comprehensive research are captured in the CeVET Mapping Report, which will soon be available on the CeVET project website.
- ◆ **CeVET Selection:** Following the research phase, partners identified and nominated a cohort of VET trainers with extensive experience supporting individuals with intellectual disabilities. This group played a key role in highlighting best practices and innovative approaches within the field.
- ◆ **CeVET Training:** Building on these findings, partners have gathered practical examples of the Customised Employment model in action. These methodologies will inform the design of upcoming project outputs and guide our approach throughout the remainder of the project lifecycle.

PROJECT RESULTS

As we move forward, here's what you can expect throughout the lifecycle of the project. Our goal is to support everyone through the principles and practice of Customised Employment.

1. **Customised Employment Transnational Mapping Report**
 - The Ce-VET Customised Employment Transnational Mapping Report includes real-world cases across partner countries. Using the CE Fidelity Framework, this report assesses the quality, consistency, and effectiveness of CE implementation across Europe. The findings aim to inform recommendations for practitioners and policymakers within this sector.
2. **CE Job Developer's Handbook**
 - A practical guide for employment specialists, offering tools, templates, and best practices to implement CE in diverse contexts.
3. **CE Curriculum and Training Programme**
 - A flexible, modular training package to enhance the skills and competences of VET professionals working with individuals with ID.

The CeVET partnership held its second face-to-face meeting in Valladolid, Spain, in April 2025. This event marked the official launch of the project and gave partners the opportunity to align on the shared vision, work plan, and upcoming priorities.
