Project Overview

CEVET – Customised Employment to support VET Training is a 30-month Erasmus+ project that aims to improve employment outcomes for people with intellectual disabilities (ID) by embedding Customised Employment (CE) strategies into vocational education and training (VET) systems across Europe.

The project brings together six organisations from five countries - Norway, Germany, Ireland, Italy, and Spain to pilot CE practices, develop training and resources for employment specialists, and build bridges between the VET sector and disability services.

Project Objectives

- Adapt and implement the Customised Employment model across different national contexts.
- Train and upskill VET professionals and job coaches using a CE-based curriculum.
- Develop practical tools and resources to guide inclusive employment practices.
- Promote policy awareness and foster collaboration between VET providers and disability inclusion stakeholders.



Project Results

In the upcoming months, partners will produce the following results:

Customised Employment Transnational Mapping Report

The CEVET Customised Employment Transnational Mapping Report includes real-world cases across partner countries. Using the CE Fidelity Framework, this report assesses the quality, consistency, and effectiveness of CE implementation across Europe. The findings aim to inform recommendations for practitioners and policymakers within this sector.

CE Job Developer's Handbook


A practical guide for employment specialists, offering tools, templates, and best practices to implement CE in diverse contexts.

CE Curriculum and Training Programme

A flexible, modular training package to enhance the skills and competences of VET professionals working with individuals with ID.

Kick-off Meeting

The CEVET partnership held its Kick-Off Meeting in Sandefjord, Norway, in October, 2024. This event marked the official launch of the project and gave partners the opportunity to align on the shared vision, work plan, and upcoming priorities.



What's Next?

Partners are currently working on the testing and evaluation phase, identifying pilot cases and engaging with VET professionals and employment support organisations to begin implementing and monitoring the CE model in action. This testing phase will inform the development of the CE Handbook and Curriculum later this year.
